The *Dark Knight* is one of several characters who will appear in our "participatory theatre game." The time is medieval France - the year 1414.. More characters appear on the scene as the plot unfolds. Others are created by you and other youths.

While we can tell you about the characters, the plot is something else - top secret. The best we can do is tell you that a treasure has been buried and the map lost, and that the Dark Knight doesn't want you to find it before he does. But there may be a way if you can gain skills needed to assemble a treasure map - something which takes a weekend to do.



The **Young Canadian Leadership Challenge** is a series of intriguing challenges, undertaken while camping in the great outdoors. It is great fun, continuous action and at the same time it is a fast-moving *discovery learning* experience during which what you learn emerges from within you through the creation of a role for yourselves in the drama. You will be part of a team that undertakes challenging puzzles in the woods - on a "ropes course" originally designed to train adult executives to "think outside the box." Learning in such a setting does not require months to years to accomplish. With our well-designed program, which is part theatre and part game, we measure change in hours and minutes, with something happening at every juncture which sets off a new discovery. To add to this we have learned how to cement such discoveries in place and to include attitude, values and ethics in the learning process - without imposing any of our own values on the youth who gather. In other words, there is no teaching - but a lot of learning - in an setting where safety is paramount.

The **Young Canadian Leadership Challenge** will be made available to **communities across Canada** later this year, so those interested in having a wide and deep impact on youth in their own community are encouraged to bring teams of two adults and four youth to see if this is the program they are seeking.

The program was designed by **Dr. Brian C. Bailey M.D.** and a host of experts in youth theatre and adult training - and will be presented by an ad hoc theatre troupe of volunteers.
